LES ÉCRANS DE L'AVENTURE

Dijon

35th edition, from 30 September to 4 October 2026

Preamble

All participants agree to comply with these rules.

Dates and location

Les Écrans de l'aventure, an international adventure film festival, will hold its 35th edition from 30 September to 4 October 2026 in Dijon.

Organizing Committee

The festival is organized by La Guilde with the support of the City of Dijon. The Guild is solely responsible for the official selection of the festival.

Object

The festival presents French and international documentaries about adventure in all its forms: expeditions, explorations, portraits, stories, creations... in the spirit of adventure.

Admission requirements

The duration of the films in competition will be between 10 and 120 minutes and the year of production will not be earlier than October 2024.

For foreign films, the selection committee will only accept films with a French or English version.

Short or older films can be submitted for selection but cannot be in official competition.

Registration for the pre-selection

Films are admissible until June 30, 2026.

The registration of a film is free of charge and several films by the same director can be sent for the pre-selection.

For the pre-selection, the films must be registered with the completed registration form.

Selection

The selection committee will confirm by email the official selection of the films during the summer. The organization will not pay any fees for the copying and technical organization of the screening of the films.

After receiving confirmation of the selection of your film at the festival, the following elements must be sent to us:

- 5 high-definition digital photos with the corresponding copyright;
- a 3-minute excerpt of the film in HD;
- the trailer of the film;
- the filmography and a high-definition portrait of the director;
- a press kit if applicable.

These documents may be used free of charge for the promotion and communication of the festival.

Promotion

The organizers of the festival, whose purpose is to promote the films presented at the festival, take all decisions in this regard that they deem necessary.

Broadcast rights

The films selected in competition will be paid €150 excluding tax.

Projection files

Any film selected for the official selection must be sent no later than four weeks before the festival. It can be sent to a hard disk, USB stick or download link, in a format that complies with the technical data sheet, to the address below.

The costs of shipping, customs clearance and insurance of the films are the sole responsibility of the competitors. The selected films must not include advertising breaks or the logo of an advertiser or broadcaster in the image. The festival will cover the costs of reshipping the selected films.

Responsibility

The Guild declines all responsibility in the event of loss or damage to a physical medium sent to it.

Representation

The festival covers the costs of transport, accommodation and catering for one or two people representing the film for all or part of the duration of the festival (protagonist, director, producer, author, etc.)

In the absence of a performance, the festival organization reserves the right not to register the film in competition.

Juries and prizes

Several juries establish the festival's winners:

- A film jury made up of professionals, specialists in documentary film and the adventure world. The jury's decisions are final. In the event of a tie, the vote of its President counts double.
- A jury of five young people from the Children's Municipal Council of the city of Dijon.
- The festival audience.
- A book jury made up of writers and personalities from the literary world.
- The Guild.

The juries will award the following prizes:

For the films:

- the Golden Fleece for Adventure Film, endowed with €1,000 by the city of Dijon and awarded to the director;
- the Special Jury Prize;
- the Jean-Marc Boivin Award for the authenticity of a lived adventure;
- the Youth Prize of the City of Dijon;
- the Écrans de l'aventure Audience Award;

For books:

- the Golden Fleece for the adventure book, endowed with €500 and given to the author

For Adventurer Careers:

- the Golden Fleece for Adventurer of the Year, endowed by La Guilde.

Additional grants may be awarded.

Additional Broadcasts

The award-winning films will be able to be rebroadcast in theaters and within the festival perimeter within 24 hours of the announcement of the winners.
